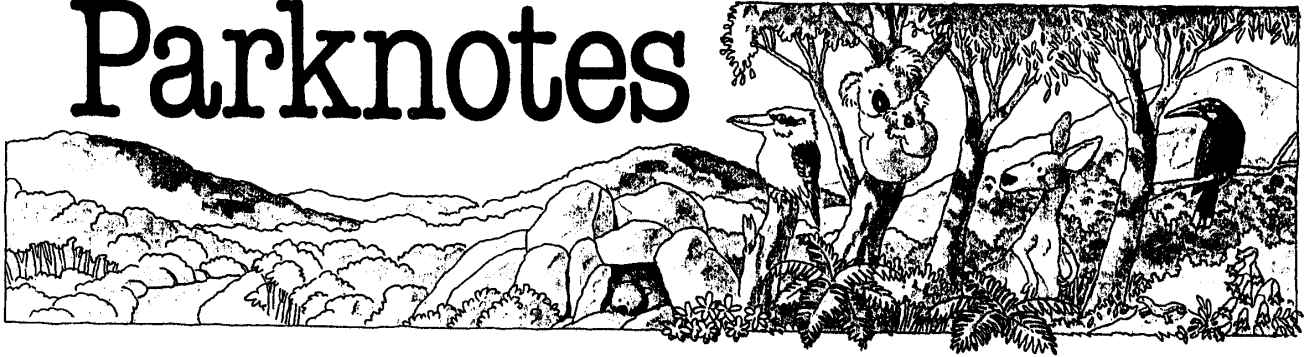


# Parknotes
