About 20 trays were replaced from the seasonal losses with Manna gum and Blackwood. The watering system is now working evenly.

The species list for planting this year include; silver wattle, Hazel Pomaderris, Musk Daisy Bush, Manna, Swamp, Messmate and some Blue Gums from last year.
